Graduated from San José La Salle de Colón, Republic of Panama in 1973. The Lord has made use of this useless servant and since I made my first consecration in the Signum Fidei Fraternity in 1978, I have always been able to motivate many former students who supported the mission of San José school for five years, then for the next twenty years in the Pastoral Ministry of the La Salle School in Panama and since 2007 in the administration of two San Miguel Febres Cordero schools, which serve more than 2,100 students free of charge, in agreement with the Ministry of Education and the De La Salle Brothers.

Each change of commitment was at the request of the Brother Visitor. It is a work of God in favour of the most disadvantaged.

In the pandemic and with teleworking, as a family we create some space during coffee break every morning and at lunch time every Saturday and Sunday. We pray before serving what I have prepared for them; always thanking God for so many blessings, together with my wife Noemi and our 3 children and 5 grandchildren.

I live next door to my 94-year-old mother-in-law and we share common areas. It is a blessing that allows us to know the loneliness of the elderly, aggravated now by the lockdowns.



We do our personal prayer and participate in the Eucharist via YouTube. Via electronic transfer we support our church, family members, neighbours, friends and sometimes unknown people. You can always help and motivate others to join in.
